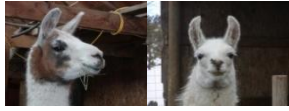

KNITTING

Knit Help with Cary Loewen \$10 per session, payable to instructor

Get help starting a new project or bring a project that you're stuck on. Cary will help you get going.

Beginning Knit with Cary Loewen \$36.00 plus supplies

For wanna-be knitters who have never picked up sticks & string. Learn to cast on, the knit stitch, the purl stitch and bind off. Make a Loop d' Loop hat.

Felted Clogs with Cary Loewen \$36 plus supplies

Using a Fiber Trends pattern, knit these fast and easy clog slippers. When the knitting is done, throw them in the washing machine and felt down to a custom fit.

Socks with Cary Loewen \$36 plus supplies

Pamper your feet with your very own hand knit socks. Learn to knit socks on double points or circular needles. Students must be able to knit and purl.

Friday July 9 and Friday July 16 - 10 am to 12 pm

Socks on Two Circular Needles with Kirsten Maier \$36.00 plus supplies

Tried knitting socks on DPNs and wanted to know if there was another way? Never knit a sock before at all and want to give it a go? This class is for you! Knitting socks on 2 circular needles is a great technique that many avid knitters prefer. It is a very portable method and since you knit both socks at one time you avoid second sock syndrome. This class goes over how to cast on, knit, and bind off your socks when knitted using two circular needles. Basic stockinet socks are great for first timers but if you have a pattern you like feel free to bring it. This method can be used top-down or toe-up and we will focus on the toe-up method. Students should already understand the basics of knitting if attending this class. A handout with information covered in class including reference materials will be provided to students who attend. Supplies needed: 2 circular needles about 24 inches (longer is okay but a bit more awkward) in size you prefer for socks, sock yarn - any type although I do recommend skipping the elastic stretch yarns.

Crochet Socks with Kirsten Maier \$36.00 plus supplies

Want to have the comfort of a custom fit garment for your feet? Make socks! Crochet socks are not as hard as they look and they are fun to wear and comfy too! We will go over basic sock construction and you will get a pattern to get you started. You will need any weight yarn you like and an appropriate hook. For sock weight yarn 200 grams does a mid-calf pair, 100 grams makes an ankle.

Beginning Crochet 1 day with Kirsten Maier \$36.00 plus supplies

This class covers all the basics needed to get started in the wonderful world of crochet. You will learn about tools, materials, and basic techniques. In the course of the class you will complete a dishcloth as your first project. This class is well suited to people just starting out in the world of knit and crochet as well as those with experience in other crafts that want to add crochet to their bag of tricks. A handout with information covered in class including reference materials will be provided to students. Supplies needed: 1 crochet hook size H, 1 ball/skein of cotton or cotton blend yarn, 1 pair scissors.

Tunisian Crochet Techniques with Kirsten Maier \$36.00

Learn how to work in Tunisian crochet stitch also known as the afghan stitch! This class will show how to use those funny looking crochet hooks to make crochet pieces unlike any other. Class will show the basic stitch as well as a few variations and how to apply color work to this technique. Students will need a Tunisian hook in size J or size you prefer for worsted weight yarn, students will also need light colored smooth worsted weight yarn so it is easy to see how the stitches are made.

SPINNING

Beginning Spinning with Sharon Dalrymple \$55.00 includes supplies

Come create your own special handspun yarns. This series of classes will include wheel operation and maintenance, fiber preparation, worsted and woolen spinning as well as two different plying techniques. You will also learn how to operate a drum carder while using various fibers to create your own one of a kind roving.

Thursday July 29 and Thursday August 5 - 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

Spindle Spinning with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00 includes supplies

Come and discover a whole new 'twist' to spinning! Drop spindle spinning is very versatile whether you're learning the basics of spinning for the first time or you already spin on a wheel and just want a more portable method. In this class we'll learn about fiber preparation, drafting, Z and S twists, plying, and setting the twist in your new yarn.

Wednesday August 18 - 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

Spinning Self Striping Yarns with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00

Unlike the Navajo ply, which creates a 3 ply yarn, this new technique will allow you to create a 2 ply self striping yarn without getting the dreaded 'candy cane' effect. The trick is in the joining of the fiber and the sequence of colors. Basic spinning knowledge required. Supplies needed: spinning wheel, lazy kate, 3 bobbins, niddy niddy, 3 different colors of roving (1 oz each), and knitting needles size 7.

Intro to Spinning with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00 includes supplies

Want to jump into a new craft with both feet...and both hands? This accelerated, condensed class will introduce you to the fundamentals of hand spinning: wheel operation, fiber preparation, worsted drafting technique, as well as plying. A great way to test drive a new fiber skill.

Intermediate Spinning with Sharon Dalrymple \$45.00 includes fiber

This intermediate class takes a more in depth view of various spinning techniques to help you enhance your spinning and give you more control over the size and twist of your yarn. Some of the topics covered will be twists per inch (tpi); wraps per inch (wpi) and applying those to consistently spin a fine, medium or bulky yarn; recognizing the differences between worsted, woolen, semi-worsted and semi-woolen yarns. Must have basic spinning knowledge. Materials needed: Wheel, lazy kate, 3 bobbins, niddy nobby, ruler, tags to label samples and hand cards.
Thursday September 2 - 12 pm to 4 pm

Spinning Angora with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00 plus \$8 payable to instructor

Come hug a bunny! We'll compare the qualities of 3 different types of angora as we learn to spin the incredibly soft fiber. You will also learn how to blend angora with other fibers straight from the rabbit. Must have basic spinning knowledge.
Thursday September 16 - 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

Spinning Mohair with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00

We'll explore the properties of this luxurious fiber as we spin from both mohair roving and locks creating some beautiful mohair yarns. The texture of this fiber makes it well suited for making fabulous "fuzzy" yarn, funky curly or tail-spun yarn, and an encasement yarn. Must have basic spinning knowledge.

Materials needed: Wheel, lazy kate, 3 bobbins, niddy nobby, 2 oz of mohair roving, 1 oz thread, sandwich bag and rubber band to fit around wrist and tags to label yarn.

Beginning Spinning with Kirsten Maier \$36.00 includes supplies

You don't need a reason or excuse to spin. It's therapy, it's creative and it's satisfying. Come let Kirsten get you started.

Spindle Spinning with Kirsten Maier \$36.00 includes supplies

Spindle spinning is one of the most basic & oldest methods of creating yarn or thread from fibers. Learn the basic skills of spinning & try some of its varied forms. This is a good introduction to spinning on a wheel or a satisfying technique that is very portable.

Fiber Preparation with Andrew MacArthur \$24.00

What to do with those Fleeces! Now that you have your animals shorn, what's next? This class will take you through the basics of evaluating your fleece, skirting your fleece, and end products that may be suitable for your fleece type. We will also discuss what happens to your fleece at the mill and what happens at each machine. Bring a fleece and time permitting we will evaluate as many as we can. This will be very hands on class. Participants are welcome to schedule mill tours of SpringToo Fibers.

Drum Carding with Sharon Dalrymple \$36.00

Have you ever wished you could find that 'special' one of a kind roving? Then come and learn how to make your very own. This class will start with the operation and maintenance of a drum carder and then the fun begins! You will be blending colors side by side for a multi-colored roving; blending colors in layers for a heathered yarn; learning how to make a self-stripping yarn as well as how to blend different fibers for that special look. Basic spinning knowledge is required. Bring to class a wheel, 3 bobbins, a lazy kate and fiber.

Wednesday September 8 - 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

Carding a Rainbow with Christy Cooper \$40 includes supplies

Starting with the primary colors, this class will explore color by blending pre-dyed fibers using a drum carder to make a full color wheel. This is a great alternative to dyeing for spinners or felters to get the shade you're looking for, is an economic alternative to dyeing and a way to use the roving you've already bought. Blend your own color wheel and use it with a little Color Theory to design your next project. Bring your camera to get a good photo of your color wheel before you use it all up!

WEAVING

Weave a Melon Basket with Deb Greer \$65.00 plus \$20.00 materials fee paid to instructor.

Learn to weave a melon basket with rattan reed. Instructor provides weaving and frame materials,

Saturday July 10 - 10am to 4 pm

Beginning Rigid Heddle with Deb Greer \$180.00

Learn to weave on the rigid heddle loom. Make a table runner and two pillow tops or table squares. Warp and learn to weave the first two days, weave for a week and come back the following Saturday to learn finishing and re-warp your loom if desired.

Friday July 23, Saturday July 24 and Saturday July 31 - 10 am to 4 pm

Beginning Rigid Heddle Fast Track with Deb Greer \$180.00

Learn to weave on the rigid heddle loom FAST Track Class. Make a Table runner and two pillow tops. Warp and learn to weave, weave every night as homework.

Thursday August 26, Friday August 27 and Saturday August 28 - 10 am to 4 pm

Navajo Saddle Cinch Tapestry with Deb Greer \$150.00

Learn Navajo Tapestry techniques (Plain weave) on a narrow band. Warping is fast and easy. Navajo or frame type loom required. \$5.00 materials fee for pre-made warp, and you will need to obtain some D-rings for the weaving, sources in the materials list when you sign up. Navajo looms can be rented from instructor or shop.

Friday August 20 and Saturday August 21 - 10 am to 4 pm

Diamond Twill Variations on 4 harnesses with Deb Greer \$180.00

Learn to thread a diamond twill, treadle variations in pattern and color. Two Table Runners will be woven at different setts on the same warp to learn these techniques and discussion for adaptation to anything from saddle blankets to baby blankets. Bring your loom or use one at the shop. Warp at home from provided draft or in a \$50 warping session on a day prior to class.

Thursday September 16, Friday September 17 and Saturday September 18 - 10 am to 4 pm

Double weave with Deb Greer \$150.00

Weave a tube, intertwined layers, 2 separate layers, and double width. Sample by weaving each method on the same warp to learn the techniques and project ideas for use of samples. Warp at home from provided draft or in a \$50 warping session on a day prior to class. Bring your loom or use one at the shop.

Friday September 24 and Saturday September 25 - 10 am to 4 pm

Two Face Mini Saddle Blanket on 2-4 harnesses with Deb Greer \$150.00

Learn to warp and weave a mini saddle blanket that has two different faces. 2 harness minimum, your loom or shop loom. If you would like to learn this off-beat method, call the shop or Deb at 719-499-3874.2

DYEING

Fun with Color on Yarn with Christy Cooper \$40 includes supplies

Learn how to dye with acid dyes. You will experiment with color and dye application. Christy will fill you with color confidence! Students will be using Jacquard Acid Dyes. Acid dyes are environmentally safe. The 'acid' is vinegar.

Fun with Color on Roving with Christy Cooper \$36.00 includes supplies

Having problems finding just the right shade of roving for your next spinning or felting project? Dye it yourself using acid dyes! Learn how to dye roving with Acid Dyes with Christy. Learn to blend your own colors from the dyer's primary colors, and how to handle roving without felting it before you want it felted!

Indigo Dyeing with Donna Brown \$80.00 includes supplies

Explore the fun and magical process of creating blue color with indigo. You will learn 2 methods for indigo dyeing; preparing a hydrosulfide indigo vat and easy indigo dyeing using Table Rock's pre-reduced indigo. Whether you are interested in setting up a dye pot or want to better understand and experience indigo dyeing this class is for you! One pound of wool yarn is supplied. You may also bring wool or silk yarn or fabric (washed and wetted out ready to dye) with you to put in the indigo pot. Yarns needing over dyeing are also welcome. No prior experience with dyeing is necessary. Bring a lunch.

Colorful Sock Blank Dying using Natural Dye Extracts with Donna Brown \$80.00 includes supplies

Create your own colorful hand dyed socks using eco-friendly natural dye extracts. Sock blanks are pre-knit fingering weight merino/nylon blend sock yarn squares. Using pre-mordanted blanks and mixing natural dye extracts, each student will paint their sock blank that will knit into a pair of colorful variegated socks. Techniques for creating a variety of color patterns on socks will be explored. No prior experience with dyeing is necessary. Bring a lunch.
